



Confidentiality Agreement

Confidentiality is a very important aspect of education. Pertinent information pertaining to individual students is available to those who volunteer in the school. Confidentiality rules include:

3. Do not discuss personal situations regarding students.
4. Never give any type of information regarding students to nonschool parties.
5. Avoid personal involvement with students. Refer students who request help with personal problems to the teacher.
